

## **Miriam Vishio Receives Attorney General's Distinguished Service Award**

Zelle LLP is pleased to announce that Miriam (Mimi) Vishio has received the Attorney General's Distinguished Service Award for the outstanding work she did in the Aetna/Humana health insurers merger trial as a Trial Attorney with the U.S. Department of Justice's Antitrust Division. The Attorney General's Distinguished Service Award is the Department of Justice's second highest performance award. Vishio was recognized for her key contributions to the Antitrust Division's trial victory blocking the proposed \$37 billion merger.

Prior to joining Zelle, Vishio led conduct and merger investigations for the Antitrust Division and served as a key member of several litigation and trial teams. At the Antitrust Division, she also received two Assistant Attorney General's Awards of Distinction for her significant contributions to the Division's antitrust enforcement efforts relating to the Electrolux/General Electric and National CineMedia/Screenvision proposed mergers that were both ultimately abandoned during trial and on the eve of trial, respectively.
